DONATION TOWARDS WORK IN SRI LANKA

We, at the Centre of Hope, thank you from the bottom of our hearts, for your generous donation towards the betterment of the communities in the North of Sri Lanka.

We invest in the lives of over 7,000 children, and approximately 800 widows, through our social outreach programs and missions work around the nation. In doing so, we have built a special relationship with communities in the North and East.

The village of Arthapilavu consists of 75+ families and is one of the furthest from the main road. After this community was resettled, its school-going children were provided with three-wheeler services to transport them to and from their school.

This service was funded by Bridge of Love, and was coordinated by our community center in Kaiveli. Your giving has blessed the communities in both Arthapilavu and Thimbili, and has given them a sense of hope.

In addition to all this, we are grateful to Mrs. Evangeline Kamalini, a trustee of Bridge of Love, for her generous donation on 24 October 2017, which was made in memory of her late husband.

Mrs. Kamalani's generosity enabled us to hire a second three-wheeler to further improve the transport service to and from schools, provide dry ration packs to 115 widows in the area, and provide cash gifts to five villagers who were disabled during the war.

We know that each of the gifts provided came as a great encouragement and strength to the recipients and their families.
