# Aim & Purpose

Bridge of Love Trust (BOL) is a non-profit organisation and a registered UK Charity (Charity No: 1096302). Rev G I Ebenezer is the chairman of BOL.

The Trust was started with the purpose of protecting and supporting the oppressed in society, especially widows and orphans. The trustees are involved in various welfare initiatives to safeguard the interests of the poor, who are often the victims of civil war in Sri Lanka.

### **Activities**

Bridge of Love confines itself to community development in the Northern and Eastern provinces of Sri Lanka and the tribal areas in Tamil Nadu, South India. Over the past fourteen and a half years we have been financially supporting registered local organisations and churches who work among the oppressed, vulnerable & abandoned, poor & needy, widows, orphans, child labour victims, the underprivileged, young offenders, the persecuted and war victims in Sri Lanka and India.

We provide monthly financial support to the vast majority of our projects. In addition to our regular financial support, we identify and assess where there is a specific need, and approach individuals & organisations for aid and financial help. We then channel these funds to trustworthy organisations to meet their needs. We try our best to ensure that the organisations we support are genuine.

We help people regardless of race or religion.

# **Summary of Achievements**

# **Covid-19 Economic Relief Projects**

Covid-19 crippled the Sri Lankan economy and has highly impacted the livelihood of the poor & needy, who are already struggling to make ends meet.

Rev Karunanithi coordinated Covid-19 economic relief projects worth more than £1,000 in Batticaloa.

Rev Kathireson coordinated Covid-19 economic relief projects worth more than £350 for the Pita Kotte slum dwellers in Colombo.

Sis Malini coordinated Covid-19 economic relief projects worth more than £250 in Visuvamadu and Mullaitheevu.

Rev Ranjit coordinated Covid-19 economic relief projects worth £750 in Nuwara Eliya.

Rev John Daniel coordinated Covid-19 economic relief projects worth £1,000 in Tiruchengode. Br Jesuthasan and Br Sutharshan are the sponsors of this project.

Br Stephen coordinated Covid-19 relief projects worth more than £250 for the poor & needy in Trichy, India.

Rev Samraj coordinated Covid-19 economic relief projects worth £225 in Vellore.

In total, we sent more than £4,000 for Covid-19 economic relief projects in 2021.

# **Educational Projects**

In 2021, we donated more than **£2,600** towards educational programmes in Batticaloa, Mullaitheevu, Colombo and Vellore. Rev Karunanithi, Rev Suresh Paul, Sis Malini and Rev Kathireson coordinated these projects for Bridge of Love.

## **Income Generating, Water Supply Projects**

Rev Karunanithi coordinated more than £300 worth Income Generating projects in Batticaloa. Bro Jesuthasan donated £1,200 for an Income Generating project in Kallaru, Kilinochchi. He also donated £500 for the construction of a tube well in the same area.

# Poor, Sick & Needy and Other

- In 2021, we donated more than £1,100 for the poor & needy / war victims in Batticaloa. Rev Karunanithi is our local project coordinator.
- We have been providing financial support to 10 underprivileged pastors in Batticaloa for more than fourteen years. In 2021, we donated more than £1,150 for this project and Rev Karunanithi is our local project coordinator.
- Mr Luke Mahendra, Treasurer of Bridge of Love (BOL), is the coordinator and the sponsor of Cannan poor pastors and he donated more than £2,150 in 2021.
- We donated more than £570 for the sick & needy in Mullaitheevu. Rev Suresh Paul and Sis Malini are our local project coordinators.
- We donated more than £625 on medical expenses for our Trichy education coordinator, Mr Jayakumar.
- We donated £350 for the children affected by HIV & AIDS in Chennai. Dr John Daniel is our local coordinator.
- We donated more than £225 for the victims of the domestic abuse in Mulaaitheevu.
   Sis Malini is our local project coordinator.

In total, we sent more than £6,500 for these projects.

### **Christmas Gifts**

In December 2021, we sent more than £2,712 worth of Christmas presents to the poor & needy in Batticaloa, Pita Kotte, Dehiwela and Trichy. Rev Karunanithi, Rev Kathireson and Br Stephen coordinated these projects for Bridge of Love.
